

ORDINANCE NO. 2021-01

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION III, SUBSECTION 6 OF SCIPIO TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE NO. 2020-01 TO GIVE THE TOWNSHIP BOARD AUTHORITY TO EXTEND THE DEADLINE THAT THE CONDITIONALLY LICENSED APPLICANT MUST SUBMIT PROOF TO THE CLERK THAT THE APPLICANT HAS SUBMITTED A FULL APPLICATION TO THE STATE OF MICHIGAN FOR THE ISSUANCE OF A STATE OPERATING LICENSE.

THE TOWNSHIP OF SCIPIO ORDAINS THAT:

Section III, Subsection 6 of Scipio Township Ordinance No. 2020-01 is hereby amended to state as follows:


Section III, Subsection 6:


6. Within thirty days from the issuance of a conditional license from the Township, the conditionally licensed applicant must submit proof to the Clerk that the applicant has submitted a full application to the State of Michigan for the issuance of a state operating license. If the applicant fails to submit such proof, then such conditional license shall be canceled by the Clerk and the conditional license shall be available to the next applicant in consecutive time and date-stamped order as provided for in subsection 4 above. *The Township Board shall have authority to extend the deadline to obtain full authorization for up to an additional six months on written request of the applicant, within thirty days prior to cancellation, upon the reasonable discretion of the Township Board finding good cause for the extension.*

All other provisions of Scipio Township Ordinance No. 2020-01 not specifically amended herein shall remain in full force and effect.

This ordinance shall take effect 30 days after its first publication as provided by MCL 41.184 (2)(a).

The foregoing ordinance was duly adopted at a regular meeting of the Scipio Township Board held on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2021.
