

ORDINANCE NO. 2017-03

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 10 OF SCIPIO TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE  
NO. 85-1 TO PROVIDE FOR TREATMENT OF VIOLATIONS OF ORDINANCE  
NO. 85-1 AS A MUNICIPAL CIVIL INFRACTION**

THE TOWNSHIP OF SCIPIO ORDAINS THAT:

Section 10 of Scpio Township Ordinance No. 85-1 is hereby amended to state as follows:

Section 10: Penalty.

(a) Civil Fine. A person who violates any provision of this Ordinance is responsible for a municipal civil infraction, and upon an admission or finding of responsibility therefore shall be assessed a civil fine in the amount as provided herein, plus any costs, damages, expenses and other sanctions, as authorized under Chapter 87 of the Revised Judicature Act, as amended, and other applicable laws.

(b) Amount of Civil Fine. The civil fine for a violation shall not be less than \$50.00 nor more than \$500.00, in the discretion of the court, together with costs of the action, which are not limited to the costs in ordinary civil actions and which may include all expenses, direct and indirect, to which the Township has been put in connection with the municipal civil infraction up until the entry of judgment, and such other assessments, damages, and expenses as are allowed by law.

(c) Additional Judgments, Writs, or Orders. In addition to any other penalties assessed, upon an admission or finding of responsibility for a violation of this Ordinance, the district court may issue and enforce any judgment, writ, or order necessary to enforce this Ordinance.


(d) Each Day A Separate Violation. Each day that a violation is permitted to exist or continue shall constitute a separate violation.


(e) Injunctive relief. In addition to any remedies available at law, the Township may bring an action for an injunction or other process against a person to restrain, prevent or abate any violation of this Ordinance.

All other provisions of Scpio Township Ordinance No. 85-1 not specifically amended herein shall remain in full force and effect.

This ordinance shall take effect 30 days after its first publication as provided by MCL 41.184(2)(a).
