

**SCIPIO TOWNSHIP  
ORDINANCE NO. 2026-01**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION VI OF ORDINANCE 2020-01 TO CHANGE THE TITLE OF SECTION VI OF THE ORDINANCE, TO AMEND SECTION VI.1.n TO CLARIFY THAT IT IS APPLICABLE TO ALL TYPES OF LICENSED MARIHUANA ESTABLISHMENTS AND MEDICAL MARIHUANA FACILITIES, AND TO DELETE SECTION VI.2.i AS REDUNDANT AND REDESIGNATE SECTIONS VI.2.j, VI.2.k, AND VI.2.l AS SECTIONS VI.2.i, VI.2.j, AND VI.2.k, RESPECTIVELY.

WHEREAS, the Township of Scipio has previously adopted Ordinance Number 2020-01 authorizing the issuance of various types of licenses for marihuana facilities and marihuana establishments, which Ordinance was amended by Ordinance 2021-01; and

WHEREAS, the Township Board has determined that there is a typographical error in Section VI.1.n of the Ordinance that may not make it clear that the intention of said provision is that it apply to the operations of all types of licensed marihuana facilities and marihuana establishments within the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Township Board has also determined that the title of Section VI should be amended to make it clear that it provides for operations standards applicable to all types of licensed marihuana facilities and marihuana establishments within the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Township Board has further determined that upon the amendment of Section VI.1.n as provided herein, Section VI.2.i will be rendered redundant and, as such should be deleted;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE TOWNSHIP OF SCIPIO ORDAINS THAT SCIPIO TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE NUMBER 2020-01, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NUMBER 2021-01, SHALL BE AND IS HEREBY AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED that the title of Section VI is hereby amended to state as follows:

**SECTION VI**  
**OPERATIONAL STANDARDS FOR AUTHORIZED**  
**MARIHUANA ESTABLISHMENTS AND MEDICAL MARIHUANA FACILITIES**

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED that Section VI.1.n is hereby amended to state as follows:

n) The licensed premises shall not be operated in a manner creating noise, dust, vibration, glare, fumes or odors detectable to normal senses beyond the boundaries of the property on which the licensed operations are conducted. With respect to fumes and odors for all retail and other indoor operations, including, without limitation, indoor grow operations, fumes and odor must be managed by

the installation of a suitable operable filtration system connected to appropriate ventilation and exhaust equipment, and fumes and odors must otherwise be effectively confined to the interior of the building from which the fumes and odors are generated.

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED that Section VI.2.i is hereby deleted as redundant, and current Sections VI.2.j, VI.2.k, and VI.2.l are hereby redesignated as Sections VI.2.i, VI.2.j, and VI.2.k, respectively.


IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED that a prosecution that is pending on the effective date of this ordinance and which arose from a violation of an ordinance or a portion of an ordinance repealed or deleted by this ordinance, or a prosecution which is started within one (1) year after the effective date of this ordinance arising from a violation of an ordinance or a portion of an ordinance repealed or deleted by this ordinance and which was committed prior to the effective date of this ordinance, shall be tried and determined exactly as if the ordinance or applicable portion thereof had not been repealed or deleted.

This ordinance shall take effect 30 days after its first publication as provided by MCL 41.184(2)(a).

The foregoing ordinance was duly adopted at a regular meeting of the Scipio Township Board held on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2026.
